## **Honors Course Form: Proposal**

All Honors candidates must designate **one** course from their major program as an **Honors Course** (course must be at the 300 or 400 level). The professor, in consultation with the student, will determine an appropriate **Honors component** for the course. <u>An Honors component might</u> <u>involve writing a more in-depth paper in a particular area of interest, additional readings, a</u> <u>presentation, or other modifications to a course's requirements.</u> Ideally, the extra assignment will relate to the honors thesis in some way, perhaps taking up a similar topic though in a different piece of literature.
